

- Target for 2021/22 = 100 Ha



### Launch of The **Queen's Green Canopy**


The Queen joined The Prince of Wales for the first Jubilee tree planting in the grounds of Windsor Castle in Spring 2021 to mark the launch of the **QGC** initiative.

### Training programme for unemployed young people

The **QGC** will also create a pilot training programme for unemployed young people aged between 16-24 through Capel Manor College, London's only specialist environmental college to plant and manage trees.



## Tree potting:

Put some soil in pot. Add tree. Cover roots in pot with soil. Water.

Add your name on card and insert it into the soil.

Give me your contact details if you are taking it home to nurture until the planting at Berryfields Park on Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> November, 3pm.

Keep outside.

## Daffodil potting:


Put some soil in pot. Add 1 - 3 bulbs. Cover with soil. Water.

Keep outside.

Bulbs have a lot of their goodness contained in them, so as long as they are not left to dry out, they should do well in a pot for the first year.

After flowering, replanted in a garden, if possible, for another year.


