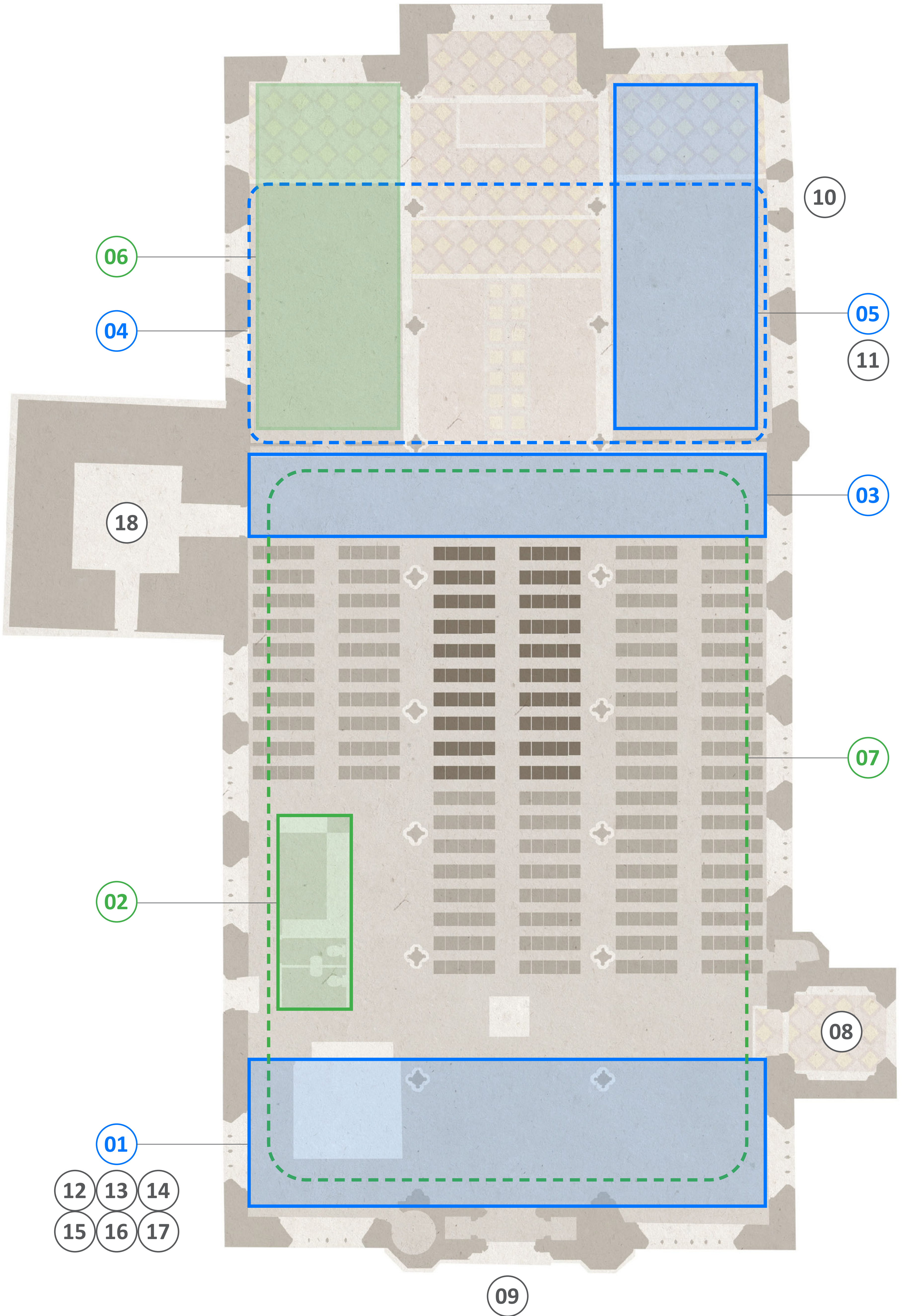
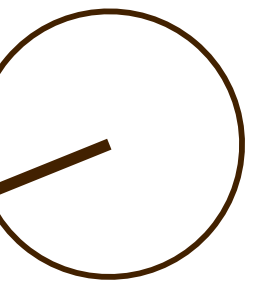


02. Diagram of Initial Concepts

Strategic Concepts

- 01.** Consolidate facilities at west end of nave as 'backdrop' for worship and events
- 02.** Free up space in north aisle for better seating and circulation.
- 03.** Re-order the chancel crossing to manage level changes
- 04.** Raise level of chancel floor to create level access via South West Priest's Door and improve visibility during worship and events
- 05.** Consolidate vestry uses into under-utilised Lady Chapel, including improved 'back of house' during evening events use
- 06.** Free up space in St.Maurice Chapel to better interpret church history
- 07.** Create 'ambulatory' of circulation around perimeter of nave to separate new elements from existing walls, windows and monuments

Works

- 08.** Retain entrance from South West porch with improved access
- 09.** Create an external ramp to create level threshold access via West Door
- 10.** Raised floor achieves level access via south east door.
- 11.** Create acoustically enclosed flexible meeting room for Sunday School use
- 12.** Refurbish and raise organ onto gallery- achieving new floor space beneath
- 13.** Enlarged kitchen- improving welcome and refreshments during worship
- 14.** Enlarged WCs- replanned to improve access during busy periods
- 15.** Enlarged storage areas- replanned to suit the significance of the church
- 16.** Arrival lobby- with glazed doors to maximise impressive view upon arrival
- 17.** Audio desk on first floor gallery to improve performance sound and logistics
- 18.** New heating system fed by mains gas and air source heat pump to replace existing oil boiler and tank. Radiators to nave and underfloor heating to areas of raised floor level in chancel.
